The Scholarship was created to financially assist students who are interested in furthering their education in the field of Fire Fighting, Emergency Medical Services, or other Health related fields including, but not limited to: Nursing, Associates in Nursing, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Radiology, Physician’s Assistant, and Dental to name a few.

The Eric Davis Scholarship is offered to any student of Twin Valley High School who has been accepted at an institute of higher learning to further their education.

The student who receives the scholarship will be required to present a transcript showing passing grades at the end of their first semester and to be enrolled in their second semester.

At that time, the scholarship check will be issued to the individual.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Student must have a minimum of a 2.5 G.P.A at high school graduation
- 2. Student must provide a copy of their high school transcript
- 3. Student must provide a short essay explaining their goals for the future and how their education will benefit others. Essay must be more than 100, and less than 500 words.
- 4. Application must be received by May ^{31st} to be considered.
